

Mindball Play - Brainlink to Mac Instructions

Setup:

You will need your computer to be able to communicate with the headband. This is done via Bluetooth, so your computer must have built in Bluetooth or an USB adapter installed.

Download ThinkGear Connector here:

Make sure Bluetooth is activated on your computer. Activate and pair the headband you want to use.

Note that ThinkGear Connector won't detect the BrainLink until you launch Mindball Play and enable the "Use Headband" setting.

If you use Mindball Play on more than one computer in the same room/area, it can be helpful to only pair each BrainLink with one of the computers. Otherwise multiple computers may try to use the same headband, resulting in only one computer detecting it.

Usage:

To power on BrainLink, press and hold the button until the unit beeps two times. The indicator light will flash blue when the unit is on.

To power off, press and hold the button for 1 second. When released the unit beeps once. BrainLink headbands that are on and paired will be automatically detect by Mindball Play.

Known problems:

At this moment ThinkGear Connector only supports one headband connection on Mac.
